As we celebrate 40 years of incredible moments and the gift from the Robins family that made the facility possible, we must direct our focus to its renovation and enhancement.


These improvements will allow the University and athletics department to meet the principles outlined in The Richmond Promise and the Athletics Strategic Plan. The football hallway is the first step.
